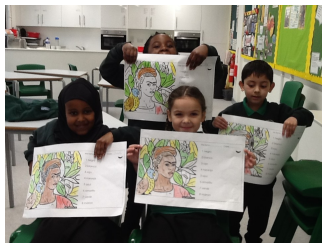

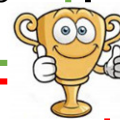

The council suggests the number of cars will be way higher than what they stated in the consultation - so we're currently asking council officers to explain and defend their position.
