

Maths: You should be completing one 10 minute test and one revision task from your CGP books every day. If you have access to a tablet or computer then please remember to Doodle.

This week's additional maths task is to plan the summer fair. You have a budget of £500 but you must make 100% profit. This means that you must include how you are going to raise money. You will need to investigate prices of things like cakes, sweets and snacks. Activities for people to pay for, eg: beat the goalie and face painting. Remember that you have to spend money to make money, but you HAVE to make a profit. You will have to use all of your arithmetic skills to make sure you cost everything correctly. You don't want to run out of stock (things for people to buy) or have much left over so choose your items wisely. Once you have planned your fair you can upload your work into teams.

English: You should be completing one 10 minute test (SPAG or Reading) and one revision task from your CGP books every day. You should also be reading your take home reading book for at least 10 mins a day.

Your additional English task this week is to create your own super hero. Day 1: What makes a good super hero? Use the website [www.marvelkids.com](http://www.marvelkids.com) to research comic book superheroes.

Day 2: Create your own Super hero using your research. You could either write a description or create a fact file.

Day 3: Create a comic strip which shows your hero in action.

Day 4: Create a Newsround report about how your hero (did or didn't) save the day. Watch Newsround to help you. Remember reporters use formal language.

Spelling:

Choose 5 words from your 5/6 word bank. Find definitions for them in a dictionary or by using the internet. Create a poster like we do in guided reading ☺. Include: definition, word class, synonyms, how to use it in a sentence. Can you challenge yourself to use your words in conversation over the week?

Science: Investigate: Does the angle of a light source affect the length of a shadow? If you don't have a torch you can use the light on an iPhone or device.

Classify: Explore your home. Can you classify items around your house into opaque, translucent and transparent?

Geography: Research and compare Easter celebrations in Spain and the Uk. What are the main similarities and differences? Are there other festivals/celebrations that you can make comparisons about? What are they and how are they celebrated.

DT: Help your parent/carer make a meal. How much does this meal cost for your family? How much would it cost for one portion? If you were to sell it, how much would you charge? What would your profit be? Can you create a poster to advertise it? If you can, take pictures and upload them to teams.

PE: If you have a garden then challenge yourself to the mile. You will have to time yourself, but we think that if you keep moving (quick walk or steady jog) for about 12 minutes you will have completed a mile.
