MATHS

This week we are focusing on doubling. We have learnt that doubling is a special type of adding where you add the number to itself.

Find some objects at home and try to double these, e.g. 1 orange and 1 orange, 3 pencils and another 3 pencils.

See if your child can write the number sentence for these- $1+1=2$, $3+3=6$ and then see if they can investigate their own doubling problems using objects to find the answer, e.g. what is $15+15$?




EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN
