

English: This week we will be focussing on lots of different grammar features and English targets we have learnt over the year.

Monday: Relative clauses – watch the video which explains how to use relative clauses. Then complete the sheet. Remember, relative clauses use the relative pronouns (who, that, which, whose).

Tuesday: Watch the video on expanded noun phrases and prepositions. Complete the worksheet on including expanded noun phrases modified by a preposition.

Wednesday: Watch the video on using subordinate clauses. Complete the sheet on using subordinate clauses with varying positions.

Thursday: Watch the video's on using brackets and dashes for parenthesis. Complete the worksheet on including dashes and brackets in your writing. Think back to a few weeks ago when we did this.

Friday: Watch the video on adverbial phrases. Use this to help you complete the sheet on starting sentences with adverbial phrases.
