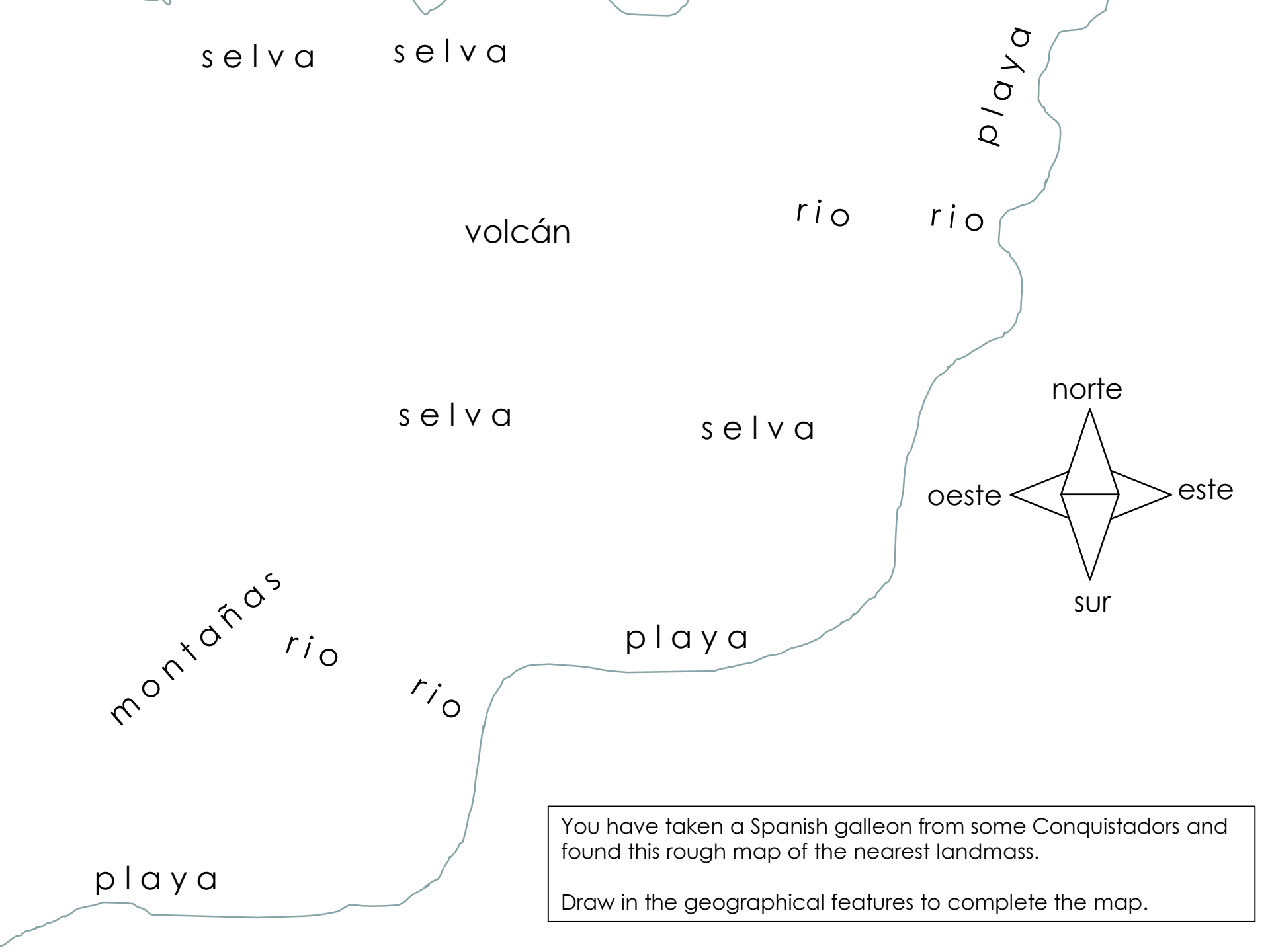


During the Sixteenth Century, The Conquistadors sailed away from Spain, trying to find a quicker route to India, where they could buy beautiful silks and spices.

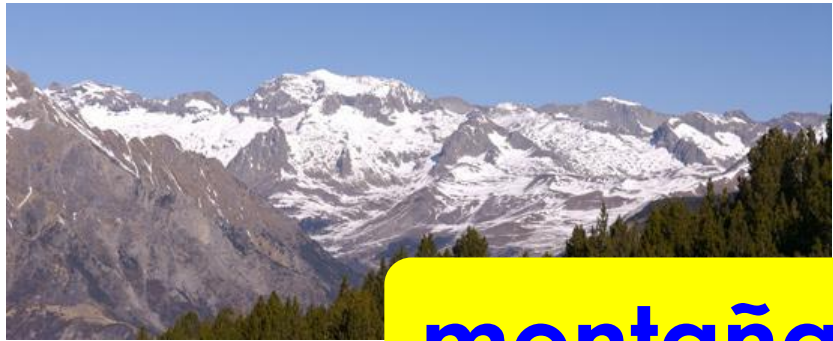
